Go Forth and Reproduce									
<p>Description: : This unit builds upon students' knowledge and understanding of the male and female reproductive systems, contraception methods, Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI's) and the problems and responsibilities with teenage pregnancies. Students will also investigate a range of assisted reproductive technologies (eg IVF, GIFT, surrogacy). It provides a foundation for the subsequent units of work completed during year 10.</p>

All About Pregnancy									
<p>Description: This unit describes all aspects of pregnancy care that are widely applicable throughout Australia. From pre-conception through to family preparation, the nine month journey equips students with knowledge of the different stages of pregnancy, the physical, social and emotional changes during pregnancy and planning to have a family. Within this unit, students not only increase their knowledge and understanding of the issues surrounding pregnancy, but also become aware of, and learn to access, a range of relevant community resources and services.</p>

Labour and Childbirth									
Description: In this unit students will be able to describe the stages of labour for both the mother and the baby, compare and contrast different settings and locations for delivery, evaluate various methods of pain management, and examine a range of possible complications associated with the birthing process (eg premature birth, breech and still-born babies).									
Outcomes: 1.2, 2.2, 2.3, 3.2, 3.3									
Assessment: Students will be given an A-E grade based on their 'Birthing Method Informative Presentation' (Week 10).									

Term 4 - 10 weeks

Description: In this unit students will learn how to care for and support a newborn, recognise the needs of a newborn, explore the range of equipment and resources available to assist in the care of a newborn and investigate the benefits of breastfeeding and the options available for mothers who have difficulty.

Assessment: Students will be given an A-E grade based on their 'RealCare Baby Simulation' (Ongoing- Term 1-4).
