Bright Futures at The Park

Mathematics and Visual Arts 'scooped the pool' at Albion Park High this year with four Band 6s in Mathematics General 2 and ten Band 5s which constituted an amazing 27% of the cohort. Mathematics 2 unit was successful in 25% of the cohort achieving Band 6.

The Mathematics faculty at Albion Park worked extremely hard to re-program and investigate how to engage students in Mathematics, especially at the top levels. The hard work has paid dividends.

The top performing Mathematics students were Jacob Lia with a fantastic 99% in Mathematics General and Luke Tripi with 95% in Advanced.





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Visual Arts not only gained two Band 6's but 50% of the class were in the top two Bands, an astounding achievement for their talented teacher.

Other outstanding results in the top two bands were:

- Community Family Studies over 47%
- Business Services 44.4%
- IDT (Web and Software Applications) 42%

Sophie Elbourn, Dux at Albion Park High, gained an ATAR of 93.85.

Photography 2019

Whitecard Course

A Whitecard course (CPCCWHS1001 - Prepare to Work Safely in the Construction Industry) will run at school on Friday, 15 March. This course is compulsory for any Year 11 VET Construction students who do not already hold this qualification. Students must hold a Whitecard so they can complete the compulsory work placement component of the course (70 hrs).

Year 11 Construction students will be given priority, but any vacancies not filled by them will be offered to other students in Year 9 - 12.

The course can have a maximum of twenty participants. The cost is \$95.

Permission notes are available from Mrs Fisher or Mr Mayo. These need to be returned to the front office with money to secure a place in the course.

EVET Courses kick off in Week 3

EVET courses are a great way for students to study courses not offered at school and in an area where they have a particular interest or passion.

Students who successfully applied for EVET courses for 2019 will begin their courses in the week beginning Monday, 11 February.

Students have been issued with a confirmation letter which indicates the venue, day and time of their course.

Depending on the course, students may need to travel to TAFE campuses (Wollongong, West Wollongong, Yallah and Shellharbour), ITeC Illawarra at Coniston or AEROTS at Albion Park Airport. Students need to make sure they have their transport plans organised - this might include a lift with a family member or public transport.

Some courses run during school hours and students will be issued with Early Leaver passes which will give them permission to be off school grounds. Mrs Cole (Head Teacher Administration) will issue the passes by the start of Week 3.

Most EVET courses run from term 1 to term 3 and students are expected to attend all classes unless they have a genuine reason not to be there. Courses do not run in the school holidays, but students may be asked to complete work placement hours during the holiday period.

Any student who is unable to attend their EVET course must notify the school and the EVET class teacher prior to the scheduled session.

Any queries relating to EVET courses can be directed to Mr Josh Carters or Mrs Allyson Fisher.

Traffic Around School Area

Please be aware that the side access road near the teachers' car park is not intended for public use, unless your child is in the Parkside centre. If you do travel on this road you should keep to a speed limit of 10kh.

Also the bus bay in front of the school, is for buses only and should not be used to drop students off. This is heavily patrolled by the parking rangers and police.


Immunisation for Year 7


